December 7 – Advent Family Night

This year for our Advent Family Night we will be decorating cut-out cookies. Cookies will be given to the families who use the Helping Hands Food Pantry, to the homebound of our parish and for our Caroling event at the nursing facilities in New Holstein on December 14. Parents are most welcome to come and help us out.

December 11- Faith Formation Sunday
