Introduction — Youth Ministry position filled by Lindsay Schultz. Lindsay previously worked with youth in court systems for 5 ½ years in Waukesha to provide mental health services. She conducted weekly home visits and created treatment plans. She grew up in the parish and was interested in getting back to the area. Lindsey is currently living in New Holstein with her husband and 4 year old daughter and 2 year old son. Initially, Lindsey will seek to understand needs of the parish and expectations for the position in the upcoming week. She will be introducing youth ministry to all three parishes in the next month and a half and anticipates a middle school and high school event in December. Any ideas for activities should be submitted or shared with Lindsay.

Sister parish discussion: Joe was contacted about the possibility of creating a sister parish relationship. Is there interest in setting up a sister parish? A sister parish would create an opportunity for our parish to develop a close relationship with another parish nationally or globally. Consideration of La Sabe as the diocese may have been affected by recent hurricane and we have a connection from a Holy Rosary parish member and past visit. Consensus that councils need to establish vision and expectations for program to review before taking any next steps.
