


We want to invite you to participate in a program called *Who Am I to Judge?* offered on formed.org.

This program answers the question: How do we talk about morality in a relativistic culture. Society tends to say that there is no absolute right or wrong for everyone. Some here may agree with that statement, while others may accept that there is a moral standard, but struggle to convincingly explain that moral conviction to others. Or simply avoid the conversation altogether for fear of offending someone else. We are all affected daily by this relativistic worldview.
